This year the **exhibitor wristband** for the 2009 fair will cost \$5. Fair personnel must put on wristbands. The following is the time schedule when bands may be purchased and put on:

Friday, July 24	9 a.m. to 7 p.m.
Sunday, July 26	10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
Monday, July 27	9 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Bands will be on sale at the fairgrounds and must be purchased no later than 8p.m. on Monday, July 27. **After that date you will have to purchase a regular priced ticket at the gate.**

Fair admission tickets for non-exhibitors will be available in advance at a discount. Interested parents can purchase them at Piggly Wiggly in Milton.

Sign up sheets will be available tonight for the 4-H awareness tent and building supervision. Badger will be providing building supervision on Friday, July 31 from 5:30 until 7:30.

Anyone 16 and older interested in judging Cloverbud projects must complete a registration form. Cloverbud projects will be judged Tuesday, July 28. See Kathy vanVeldhuisen for registration forms.

Directions: We will be doing the construction at 5647 W Fenrick Road – Take W. Memorial, which becomes Cty A. Turn right on Britt Road. Stay on Britt Road, which curves left and becomes W. Fenrick Road. Look for address on fire numbers on left side of road. The driveway is across from Partridge Hollow Drive. House is set back from the road and not visible. Take the driveway back and veer left through the trees. After that, keep to the right. As you approach the last house you will see a path and opening in the tree line to the right. You will see us through the opening. Park here and head through the opening to the construction barn.
